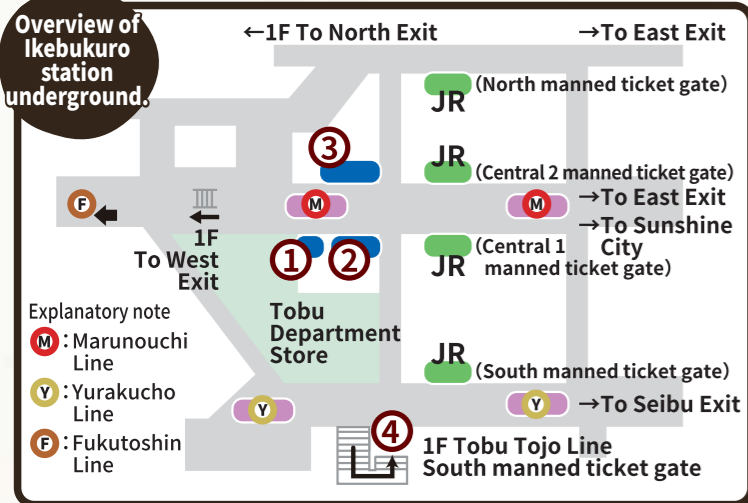


Where to buy the Discount Pass

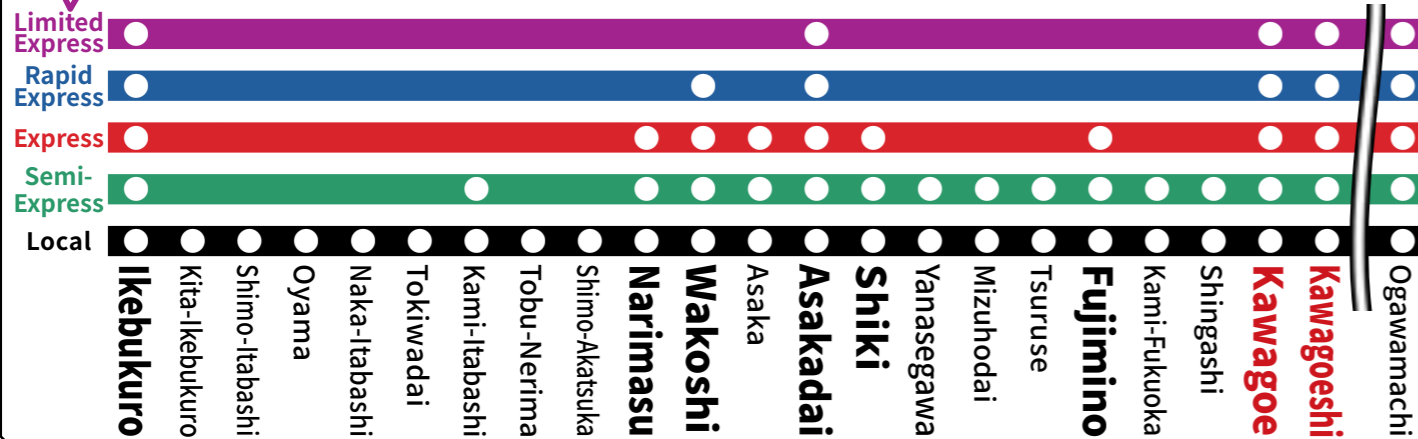
Stops on Tobu Tojo Line Ikebukuro Station~Kawagoe Station

When returning to Ikebukuro Station, please be sure to take a train bound for Ikebukuro. An extra fare will be incurred if you take a train bound for Motomachi-Chukagai or Shin-kiba.

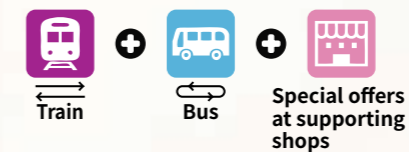

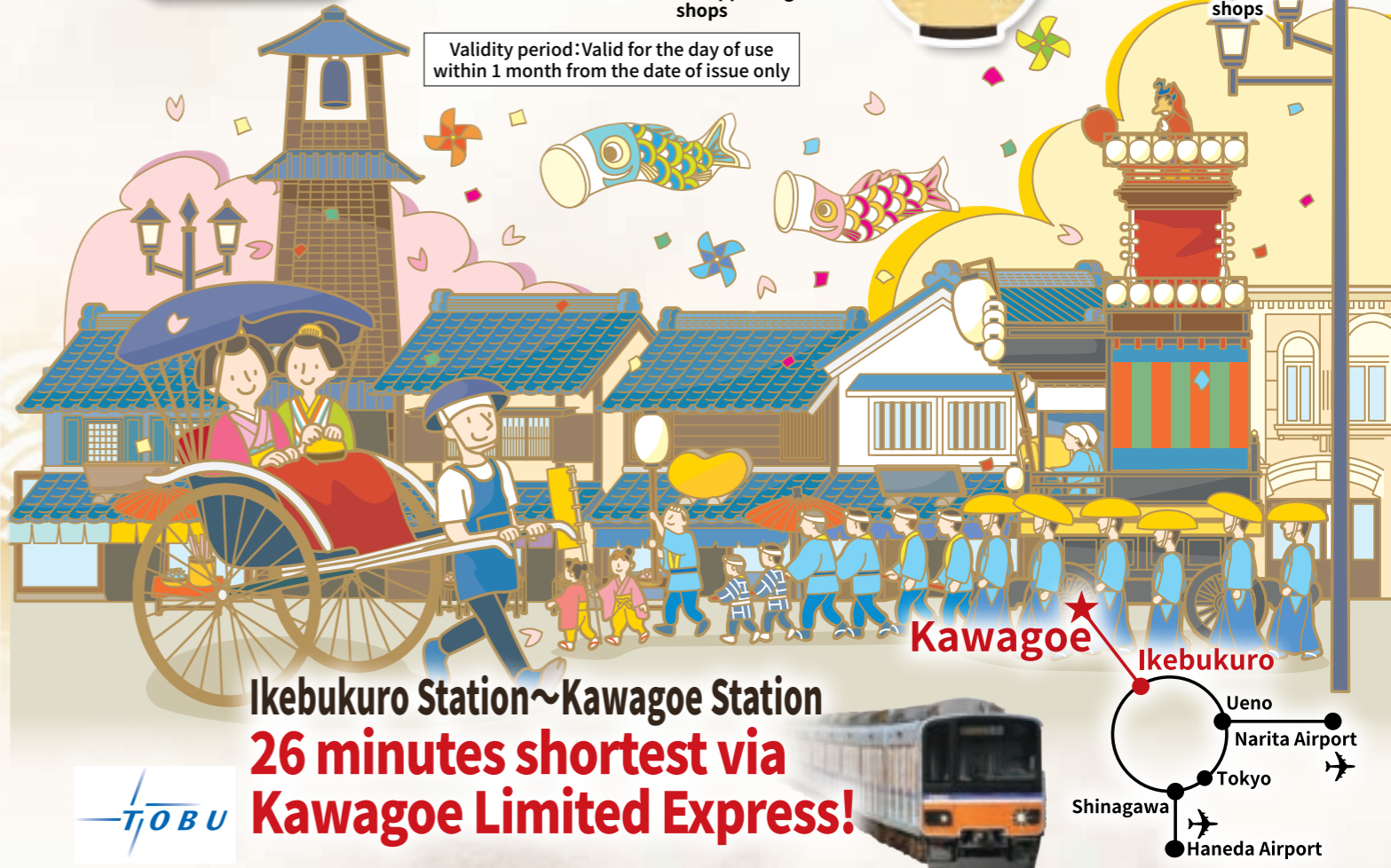
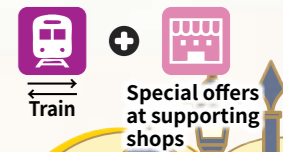

Information of 10 shops where you can get special offers.

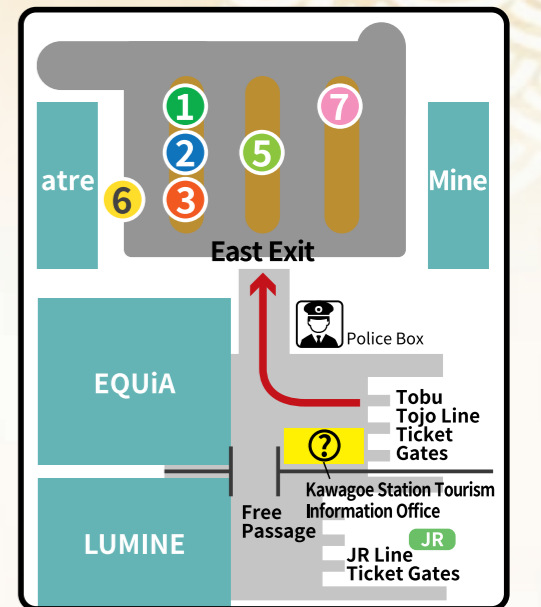

- 1 Tsuchikane Folk Arts**
A building of rugged kurazukuri-style construction. Inside, the store is full of fascinating old-fashioned pieces.
★10% discount on items purchase
- 2 Japanese Restaurant Yamaya**
Founded in 1868, this traditional ryotei restaurant is housed in a Japanese home built around a courtyard garden. Popular for its weekday lunch boxes, which offer samples of all kinds of Japanese dishes.
★One complimentary item added for "Kagome" and "Tsubasa" bento boxes during weekday lunch hours.
- 3 Torokko**
A restaurant set up in one corner of the Yamawa ceramic and porcelain store in a kurazukuri-style building. Its sweet potato mini-kaiseki course is very popular.

- 4 Koedo Kawagoe Rental Kimono Store Vivian**
Visit this kimono rental and dressing service to explore Kawagoe wearing a kimono. Making an online reservation is recommended. <http://www.coedovivian.com>

- 5 Unakko**
A restaurant specializing in grilled eel on rice. The dish with eel and sweet potato served in a bamboo steamer is excellent.
★One complimentary item with meal
- 6 Inabaya**
A shop selling handmade candies in an alley lined with sweet shops. Its Kawagoe-style sweet potato donuts are also very popular.
★One complimentary sweet potato with purchase of 1,000 yen or more (tax excluded)
- 7 Umon (Ichibangai and Toki no Kane stores)**
The store is very popular for both candies and cuisine made with sweet potatoes, such as sweet potato dumplings, sweet potatoes on rice, and more.
★5% discount for Mushitate Imokoi for eating while walking
- 8 Nagamine-en**
A tea store that passes down the tradition of historic Sayama tea to the present day. On the second floor, there is a cafe with tatami-mat floors.

- 9 Kameya (Main store and Toki no Kane store)**
A confectionery store established 230 years ago. Known for its superb bite-sized 'turtle' shaped wafers and red bean jam buns.

A famous candy shop, founded in 1914. On weekends, it is always crowded with people seeking traditional flavors.

Either the Ichibangai or Fudanotsuji bus stop is the most convenient for strolling around the kurazukuri-style storehouse buildings. Apart from the Tobu Koedo Loop Bus, Tobu Bus also operates a bus service that travels via the Kura-no-machi area, departing from the East Bus Stop No. ①②③⑤⑥. If traveling to the Kura-no-machi area, we recommend you to take a bus from either bus stop No. ① (W1-1) or bus stop No. ② (W1-2). Bus services are frequent, so you will arrive fast. You can get on and off freely within the designated travel sections. Even more convenient in combination with city route buses!

※1 It may take some time for the Tobu Koedo Loop Bus (No. ③) to arrive at the Kura-no-machi area, as it travels around various sightseeing spots.
 ※2 When traveling to Hikawa Shrine, buses departing from bus stop ⑦ are convenient. However, please take care, as these do not go to Ichibangai or Fudanotsuji.

Please note:

- Valid period: Valid only for day of use, within one month of date of issue.
- Once the valid period expires, the pass will become invalid even if not used.
- If not used and still within the valid period, passes may be handed in for a refund (deduct a handling fee) where you bought.
- If you lose your pass, it will not be reissued.**

One-point advice

Many city route buses run regularly from Kawagoe Station towards Kura-no-machi area, but if you are heading to the Kura-no-machi area, we recommend you to take the bus at Stop No. ① (W1-1) or ② (W1-2). Bus services are frequent, so you will arrive fast.
